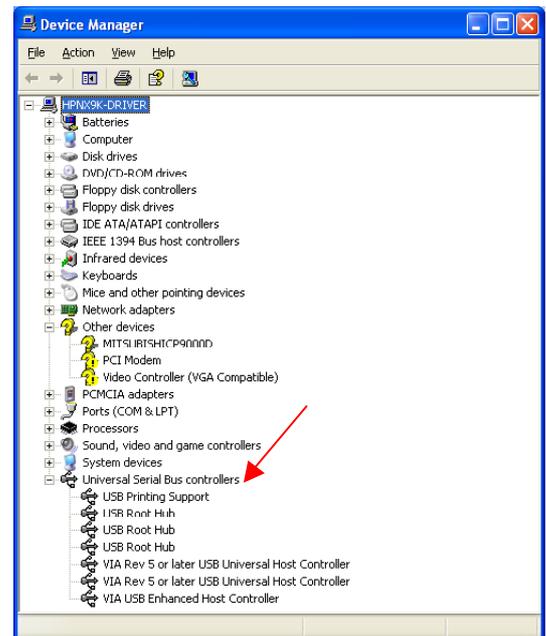


USB Driver Installation procedure (For Windows XP)

- (1) Connect CP9000D/DW to PC with USB cable.
Click Cancel, if “New Hardware Wizard” appears.

- (2) Open Device Manager.
Right click of My computer / Properties /Hardware /Device Manager.

Make sure that “USB printing support” is shown under a tree of Universal Serial Bus Controllers.

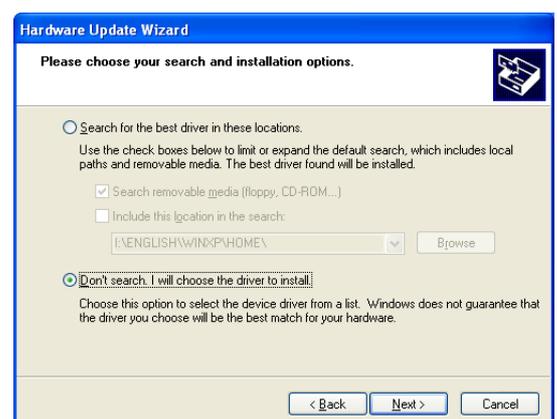


- (3) Right click “USB printing support”, then click “ Update Driver...” to start “Hardware Update Wizard”.

Select "Install from a list or specific location" and click "Next".

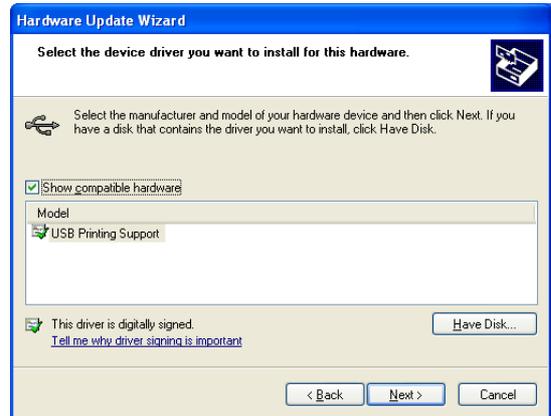


- (4) Select "Don't search. I will choose the driver to install." and click "Next"



(5) Click "Have Disk" and "Next".

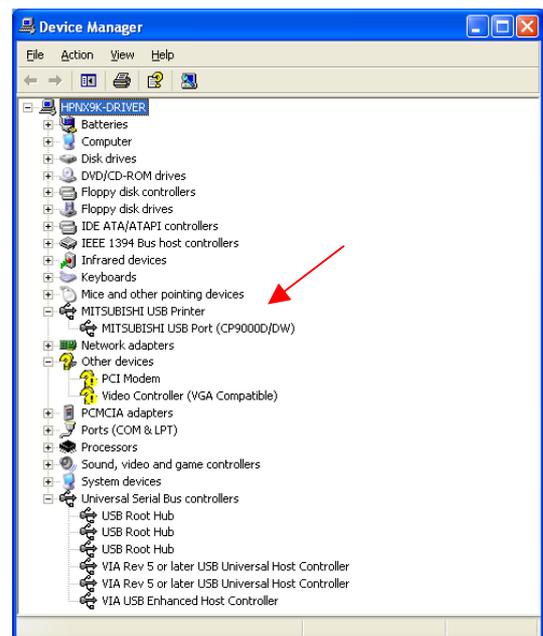
Select ".inf" file from USBDRV / Win2000XP folder of supplied USB DLL files.



(6) Click "Finish".



(7) Make sure that in Device Manager, "MITSUBISHI USB Printer" port is created, instead of "USB printing port".
